

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON

Title or Subject: AWARD BID – WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP RECREATION – SUMMER CAMP PROGRAM – MUSCONETCONG VALLEY COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION (MVCA)

WHEREAS, bids were solicited and one proposal was received for providing a summer camp program at Rock Spring Park, a Township owned park and facility; and

WHEREAS, the proposal, received from the Musconetcong Valley Community Association, was to provide a summer camp program to be held at Rock Spring Park on weekdays from the first day following the end of the 2012 school session until the day before the first day of the 2016 school session (“summer recess period”) and for the 2012-2013, 2013-2014, 2014-2015, 2015-2016 summer recess periods at a weekly rate of \$220.00 to be paid for the first child with a discount of five percent for each additional child in the same family; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Recreation has recommended that a contract be awarded to the Musconetcong Valley Community Association, Post Office Box 399, Long Valley, New Jersey 07853, in consideration of the Township receiving an annual fee in the sum of \$1,600.00 for use of Rock Spring Park.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Washington that the Mayor and the Clerk are authorized to execute a contract with the Musconetcong Valley Community Association, P.O. Box 399, Long Valley, New Jersey to allow a summer camp program at Rock Spring Park for the above dates in consideration of the payment of an annual fee of \$1,600.00 for the use of Rock Spring Park, subject to the Musconetcong Valley Community Association meeting all of the Township requirements for such use.
