Title or Subject: Long Valley Fire Company No. 1, Temporary Closure Of Fairview Avenue

WHEREAS, Long Valley Fire Company No. 1 has requested permission to close the portion of Fairview Avenue in front of the Long Valley Fire House between the hours of 4:30 pm and 10:00 pm on Saturday, June 8, 2013 in order to host a celebration of the arrival of a new fire engine; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 39:4-8 c(6) allows a municipality to approve street closings by resolution and without the approval of the commissioner for periods up to 48 consecutive hours; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has consented to the temporary closure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Washington in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey as follows:

1. That the portion of Fairview Avenue in front of the Long Valley Fire House be closed to vehicular traffic between the hours of 4:30 pm and 10:00 pm on Saturday, June 8, 2013 subject to the following conditions:
 - a) The road be able to be immediately reopened in the event of an emergency.
 - b) Written notification be provided to the residents of Fairview Avenue so that they may plan accordingly.
 - c) The details of the closure be approved by the Chief of Police or his designee.
2. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
