APPLICATIONS & DISCUSSION

1. <u>Michael McKell</u> – Block 35.03, Lot 31 – 56 Mountain Avenue – R-1 Zone – Application for Certificate of Compliance for Ridgeline, Mountainside, Hillside, View Shed protection Area

Mr. Michael McKell, the applicant, was sworn-in. Mr. McKell stated that he is proposing to build a 24 ft. x 24 ft. shed on his property and that the shed will be built adjacent to his house and to the left. He said that there is an existing parking pad and a retaining wall in this area of the property that he would like to utilize. Mr. McKell stated that the roof of the shed will be black metal and that color of the sides of the shed will match his house. He told the Board that the shed will be built from a kit.

Planner Banisch asked about the height of the shed. Mr. McKell stated that the shed will not exceed 16 feet in height. Mr. Banisch stated that the lot coverage added by the shed will be nominal and that the area is already impervious and that only 300 square feet of additional impervious will result from the shed. Mr. Banisch asked Mr. McKell about landscaping for the shed. Mr. Banisch suggested that evergreens be used. Mr. McKell stated that he would prefer not to plant arborvitae because the deer like to eat them. Mr. Banisch recommended that he plant a green giant arborvitae which he said is seldom eaten by deer or he could plant white pine or Norway spruce. Mr. Banisch stated that he believed the Certificate of Compliance could be approved with the conditions that landscaping with the noted trees be used and that the roofing and siding of the shed match the existing dwelling.

A motion was made by Mr. DiSalvo, seconded by Mr. Leavens to approve the Certificate of Compliance for Michael McKell with the conditions that the siding and roof be compatible with the existing dwelling, that landscaping be either green giant arborvitae, white pine, or Norway Spruce around the shed area, and that the height of the shed is no higher than 18 feet.

1. Sign Ordinance Amendment

The Board reviewed the sign ordinance with the minor changes recommended from the April board meeting. Mr. Banisch stated that the ordinance will prohibit LED signs with the exception of LED OPEN signs with a cap on their size being 3 square feet in area. It was noted that no blinking or flashing lights will be permitted with the exception of one month before or after a holiday.

A motion was made by Mr. DiSalvo, seconded by Mr. Trevena to send the revised sign ordinance to the Governing Body for their consideration. A roll call vote was taken and the motion carried. Ayes: Bauerlein, Trevena, Leavens, Mont, Di Salvo, Murello Nays: None Abstentions: None

2. Vouchers

Mr. Leavens made a motion to approve the vouchers reviewed by the Chairman and found in order and send them on for payment, seconded by Mr. Bauerlein. A voice vote was taken; all were in favor and the motion carried.
