

INSTRUCTIONS ON PUBLIC NOTICE

The public notice, properly filled out, must be published in the Official Newspaper of the Township: *The Observer Tribune*, 908-766-3900 or email: legals@recordernewspapers.com, or *The Daily Record*, can be published online at dailyrecord.com/public-notices 800-398-8990. This notice **must be in the paper at least ten (10) days prior to the public hearing** involving an application before the Washington Township Land Use Board Historic Preservation Advisory Board.

In addition, the notice must be served on owners of all real property within 200 feet (in all directions) either by **personal service or certified mail, not less than ten (10) days prior to the hearing date.**

[A certified list of property owners within 200 feet of the subject property may be obtained from the Washington Township Tax Assessor, 43 Schooley's Mountain Road, Long Valley, 908-876-9132.]

It may also be necessary to notify the Clerk of the adjoining municipality if the subject property is within 200 feet of the municipal boundary line.

Proof of publication and certification of service of such notice must be submitted to the Land Use Board Secretary prior to the public hearing.
